Your child will be mixing with more children when they start their new school and could be at risk of catching preventable diseases if they haven't had all their childhood jabs.

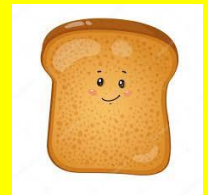
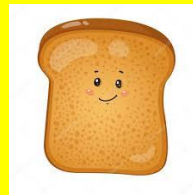
