INTRODUCING

Bromcom's MyChildAtSchool Parental Portal

MyChildAtSchool is an online portal for parents that enables them to view their child's performance at school in real-time via the web. The facility allows the child's attendance, grades and behaviour to all be accessed whenever the parent/carer wants.

As well as pupil performance data, the portal also provides general information about school, such as the school calendar and any announcements. Parents no longer need to wait for termly reports to obtain information about their child; they can check whenever they want for up-to-date information.
