Dear Families,

It has been brought to our attention that some of the children in our schools have been exposed to or made aware of unpleasant messages being spread through the internet. We have addressed some of these concerns in school and have reminded all children of the importance of talking to an adult if they ever come across something online they are unsure about.

Talking about the online world with your child can be difficult, and some topics can be particularly awkward for you and your child! As a result of this, we have found a poster which provides a series of 7 questions that will help you start an initial conversation with your child, so you have a better understanding of what they do online and how you can protect them. Additionally, it's important to note that regular conversations with your child about the Internet will help your child to build confidence when talking about online issues, and therefore help to build trust too.
