Dear Families,

We can't quite believe we are halfway through the academic year already. There are lots of things going on this half term. Please keep an eye out for further information about how our schools are celebrating World Book Day, Science Week and Sport Relief in the coming weeks.

We have also organised a **Parent Workshop** to discuss the new requirements of the Relationships and Sex Education and Health Education (RSHE) curriculum. We advertised last half term that we have an event on **Tuesday 10th March at 6pm at St Germans Academy**. All parents from across our schools are welcome to attend and we would encourage as many of you as possible to attend to hear about the changes and have your input in how we shape the curriculum to best suit the children at our schools.

It is really important that we work in partnership with parents and carers, informing them about what their children will be learning and about how they can contribute at home. We are keen to promote an age-and-stage appropriate curriculum, ensuring our children are as safe, happy and healthy as possible. In surveys, young people have said school is their first choice for RSHE, followed by their parents. We are keen to work with our parents to explore your ideas about ensuring the new legislation is embedded in the best possible way, as well as providing an opportunity to see some of the teaching resources and learn about how to build on the teaching at home.
